It also includes a thorough knowledge in quantitative methodologies for analyzing securities that is assessing their value and identify-in their underlying risks.


Why CFA[®]?

A CFA® certificate is one of the highest awards conferred in the investment industry. It is an internationally recognized designation. Chartered Financial Analysts work for investment banks, mutual fund firms, hedge funds, brokerage houses, boutique money managers. The CFA® designation represents the definitive mark of a competent financial analyst bound to the highest standards of ethical behavior. There are approximately 1,50,000 charter holders worldwide. A candidate who successfully completes the program and meets other professional requirements is awarded a "CFA charter" and becomes a "CFA charter holder."

Who should do CFA®?

Finance and investment professionals wanting to upgrade their skills in portfolio management, investment research, advisory services, or investment banking, and others who want to carve a niche for themselves in the field of financial accounting, management accounting, financial management (both as relevant to India and for the international scene), investment management, security evaluation, project planning, venture capital management and credit rating among other things.



To enroll in the **CFA** program and register for your first level 1 exam, you must have an international travel passport and one of the followings

Undergraduate education:

A bachelor's (or equivalent) degree or be in the final year of your bachelor's degree program

or

Work experience:

Four years of professional work experience (does not have to be investment related)

or

A combination of professional work experience and education that totals at least four years (part-time positions do not qualify, and the four-year total must be accrued prior to enrollment).
